### Mila's experience at the NZ Triathlon Champs

Every year there is a New Zealand secondary schools Triathlon Championship, this year it was held in Wanaka. On the afternoon of Saturday the 15th February I confirmed my registration and collected my timing chip and bib numbers, there was also a free event drink bottle. After registration we put my bike back together and tested it out. Then we went for a practise swim in lake Wanaka, it was freezing!

On race day, Sunday the 16th of February, I got up at 5am for breakfast and to prepare for the race in a couple hours. At 5.45am athletes were allowed to enter the transition area, there I racked my bike and set out my gear.

Next was the race briefing and then before I knew it I was on the start line. The Intermediate girls category all raced at once. It made it hard to know how well I was doing against my age group.

I had a great swim, a strong bike and a painful run. I knew I wasn't last but I did not know how well I had done until the electronic results were published.

When the final results were published we checked to discover I had come third in my age group!

It is my best ever placing in a Triathlon New Zealand endorsed event!
