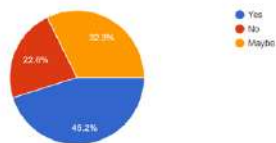

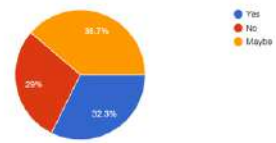
Are you clear about what your child has learned this year and the progress they have made?

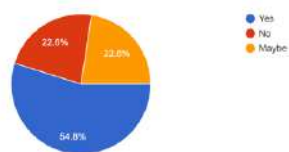
Is your child clear about what they have learned and what their next steps are?

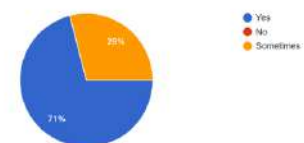
Are you able to see learning and progress clearly in real-time (as it is happening, rather than waiting for a report)?

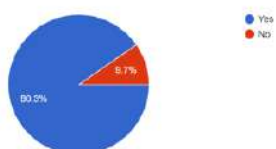
Do you comment on your child's Seesaw journal?

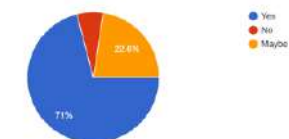
Does using Seesaw help you to have conversations with your child about school?
