



To follow on from the last newsletter, our next "Inquiry Stage" is in relation to how we filter facts. How do we know the difference between truth and opinion? Deciphering the difference can be a challenging exercise and this is an important stage of the learning process for our students. A fact is a statement that can be proven true or false. An opinion is an expression of a person's feelings that cannot be proven.



Filtering Facts Stage

What are some of the strategies used to filter facts?

- Define what a fact is
- Identify how to process, sort out and organise ideas
- Group facts together
- Keep useful facts
- Park unrelated facts



The teachers' role:

- Ask "What have you learnt?"
- Ask "How will the information be recorded?"
- Scaffold as needed to make connections with new knowledge
- Initiate discussions on findings
- Ask clarifying questions

The students' role:

- Share experiences & ideas
- Cut & sort, organise, clarify, highlight relevant information
- Choose what to keep
- Ask more questions, compare and contrast,
 list, group & label findings


